Terms and Conditions:

This competition (Bait, Set, Check and Win!) is run by Picton Dawn Chorus

Who may enter:

- Households in the Picton Dawn Chorus Project Area can take part. The project area is shown in Map 1. It includes the area from Ngakuta to Whatamango, including Picton and Waikawa townships and to the top of the Elevation heading South from Picton.
- An adult, aged 18 or over, must represent the Household in entering the competition.
- You must have an appropriate predator kill-trap placed on the property aimed at catching rats, mustelids or possums. Bait stations will not be included in the competition.
- Picton Dawn Chorus staff and committee members are excluded.

How to enter:

- To enter the competition, you must submit an entry using one of the two methods described.
 - Filing a report on the Urban Rat Trap Project page. Click here to go to The Urban Rat Project. You will need to sign up and then you will receive a reminder when it is time to submit your (catch) data. You can submit a "no catch" report each week and submit a report each time you catch a rat, mouse, stoat, weasel, ferret or possum. OR
 - Submitting a hard copy entry at the Envirohub each week <u>and</u> whenever you catch a rat, mouse, stoat, weasel, ferret or possum.
- Entries are based on the Household street address, which must include the house number to be valid.
- A maximum of 4 "no catch" entries will be included per Household, per month.
- Additional entries can be submitted for each pest (mouse, rat, weasel, stoat, ferret or possum) caught. A separate report will need to be filed for each catch.
- Only one method (online or hard copy) is to be used to submit an entry. Any duplicate entries will be removed.

Promotion Period:

- For 6 months from 1st May 2018 to 31st October 2018.
- Entries received before 23:59 on the last day of the month will be included in that month's prize draw.

Winner Selection:

Random draws are made each month by drawing, at a minimum, one random entry under police supervision within the first ten days of the following month. i.e. Before Sunday 10 June for the May Competition, Before Tuesday 10 July for the June competition etc.
